The Overseas Koreans Cooperation Center is a professional institution dedicated to the mutual development of overseas Korean communities and Korea through open communication and collaboration.


## Purpose of Establishment



## **Programs for Fostering Next Generation**

## Homecoming Camps for Next-Generation Overseas Koreans and Intensive Korean Language Camps

Programs for fostering the next generation of overseas Koreans include visits to their homeland, allowing them to experience the excellence of Korean history/culture and the progress of Korean society/economy. This helps them cultivate a sense of national identity and pride as Koreans. Additionally, by promoting exchanges and network building with the next generation in Korea, we support their growth as global leaders contributing to Korea's leading role in the global society.

Homecoming Camps for Next-Generation Overseas Koreans

We operate training programs for next-generation overseas Koreans to inspire them with knowledge of history, culture, and socio-economic development of Korea.

- Training Locations : Seoul and other provinces
- Training Period: Every summer and winter vacation (6~7 days) and specific periods in spring/fall (6~10 days)
- Number of Participants: About 3,000 (as of 2024)
   Overseas Koreans: 2,100 / Domestic Participants: 900
- Main programs: Various homeland experiences, Korean language and history/culture education, leadership training, OKFriends volunteer activities, etc.

Intensive Korean Language Camp for Next-Generation Overseas Koreans We operate programs to significantly improve the Korean language skills of Korean children living abroad and help them understand Korean culture.

- Preliminary Training: Once per session (2 days or 1 night, 2 days)
- Invitational Training: Seoul area, during summer vacation (9 nights, 10 days)
- Number of Participants: 68 (as of 2024, including local instructors)
- Main programs: Intensive Korean language education, education on Korea's development, and Korean history/ culture experiences

# Fostering Talented Next-Generation Overseas Koreans and Promoting Mutual Development

We provide scholarships to outstanding overseas Korean students. Through scholarship support, we not only alleviate financial burdens but also strengthen their connection to Korea, helping them grow into talents who can thrive in the global society.

## Scholarship Program for Overseas Koreans Enrolled at Korean Universities

We support outstanding overseas Korean students who wish to pursue bachelor's, master's, or doctoral degrees in Korea with living expenses during their studies, language training, and cultural experience programs.

- Number of Selectees: About 100 (bachelor's, master's, doctoral)
- Coverage: Living expenses (950,000 KRW per month),
   Korean language training fees, round-trip airfare, initial expenses, insurance fees, thesis printing fees
- Programs to enhance understanding and bond with the homeland: History and culture experience programs (up to 2 times), regional networking activities throughout the year, special lectures and mentoring by notable figures
- Encouraging the formation of alumni associations by region and promoting regular meetings


## Local Scholarship Support for China/ CIS Regions

We support scholarships and local networking activities for outstanding overseas Korean students enrolled at universities in China and CIS regions.

- Number of Selectees: About 140 (China region: 70, CIS region: 70)
- Support Amount per Person (annually): \$1,200 for China, Russia, Kazakhstan / \$1,000 for other regions

# Increasing the Political Influence of the Global Korean Community and Fostering Korean Identity

We aim to increase the political influence and rights of the overseas Korean community by building a network of global Korean politicians. We also operate various support programs using new media to raise the pride of overseas Koreans in their homeland.

## Global Korean Politicians Forum

We invite overseas Korean politicians including promising next–generation politicians to promote mutual understanding and knowledge sharing, thereby increasing the political influence of the overseas Korean community and contributing to mutual development and stronger ties with the homeland.






# Digital Content Development to Foster Korean Identity

## Improving Understanding of the Homeland

Ethnic education for overseas Koreans plays an important role in forming cultural bonds and fostering Korean identity. We implement customized training programs for Korean educators in special regions to help school–age overseas Koreans establish their Korean identity and properly understand Korea.

We conduct various capacity-building training sessions including traditional dance class and career counseling for teachers from Korean schools in China.

- Period and Participants: Second half of the year, teachers from Korean schools in the three northeastern provinces of China
- Implementing training tailored to actual educational fields considering local policy changes (e.g., traditional dance class, career counseling)

We invite Korean language teachers from the CIS region to improve their Korean language skills and provide them with knowledge of Korean history and culture.

- Period and Number of Participants: About 3 weeks during summer vacation each year, 20–30 participants
- Main programs: Korean language classes (divided by level), field survey for understanding Korea's history/culture and development, teaching methods classes tailored to the target audience, visits to domestic educational institutions

# Establishing an Archive and Operating a Specialized Library to Baise Awareness of Overseas Koreans

We establish a digital archive to research, collect, and preserve records related to overseas Koreans at home and abroad. The collected records are utilized in various fields such as exhibitions, education, and academic research to enhance the understanding of overseas Koreans by domestic audiences and boost the pride of overseas Koreans.

# Archive Building Project

We research, collect, and preserve records related to overseas Koreans and utilize them in various content.

- Collection and preservation of records related to overseas Koreans (documents, photos, artifacts, videos, oral recordings, etc.) at home and abroad
- Utilization of recorded videos for exhibitions and academic research, and in content aimed at enhancing the understanding of overseas Koreans

## **Library Operations**

We accumulate and provide specialized materials related to overseas Koreans, such as books, papers, and academic resources, establishing a foundation for academic research on overseas Koreans.

- Functioning as a 'Knowledge Platform for Overseas Koreans' to foster proper recognition and understanding of overseas Koreans
- Operations of online and offline libraries linked with the Overseas Koreans Archive

1 basement floor, 5 floors above ground, total area of  $6.758\,\mathrm{m}^2$ 



Smooth communication with overseas Koreans is the first step towards creating a more closely-knit global network. The Overseas Koreans Cooperation Center leads the expansion of the online Korean network and promotes active communication between Korea and the overseas Korean community through the establishment of a stable information system and service framework.

## Operation of the Overseas Koreans Information System

- Establishing online communication channels with the overseas Korean community through the center's website
- Ensuring stable operation and maintenance of the information system and information security of the Overseas Koreans Cooperation Center
- Operating online application systems for programs such as the homecoming camps and scholarship programs
